Unit 3 Exam Revision Lectures are again being run through the Schools Access Monash program. Students will have the opportunity to take part in extensive 2 ½ hour revision lectures that will build both understanding and confidence. The lectures will offer invaluable tips to tackle the exam questions, pointers on exam pitfalls from last year and give subject specific notes prepared by the experienced lecturers.
